FUND-RAISING AGREEMENT - St. Laurence Tuition Trifecta: This source of fund-raising goes into the operational fund of the budget. Each family is required to sell (30) \$10.00 tickets. Ample time is given for families to sell them. This amount is due at the August registration. Tickets are numbered and cannot be reissued.

Tuition:

4 Year Old - full day, everyday (maximum class size : 12)	\$4,000 per year

In order to qualify for 2019-2020 IN-PARISH tuition, a family must be registered at the parish AND attend minimum of 35 weekend masses at St. Laurence Church between June 1 2019 and May 31 2020. Once a family has reached the 35 Mass minimum, they will be billed according to the IN-PARISH rate. If a family only qualifies for IN-PARISH TUITION after their last April tuition payment, reimbursement will be given via a check.

Tuition will be billed and paid quarterly. Exceptions to this quarterly billing policy can be made if the family goes directly to Father to request a modification based on that family's circumstances and/or prior payment history. Each quarter's tuition will be paid upfront at the beginning of each quarter. For one student, that would be \$1075 in August, October, January, and April. For 2 students, the quarterly payment would be \$1725. If payments are not made in a timely manner (all payments will be given a grace period up to 10 days after billing date), the student will be unable to attend school.

(OVER)

If a family volunteers 20 hours of service to the school or parish per semester, it is automatically exempt from quarterly billing unless it has a history of delinquent payments. Events where volunteers are needed will be made available to families to fill at the time of enrollment. Opportunities include but are not limited to lunch-hour supervision, aftercare, monthly bingo volunteering and sports coaching. Families can also reach out directly to the Pastor or Principal with regards to other volunteer initiatives.

For any current school family that brings in a new or returning—returning defined as not having attended St. Laurence School for 12 months preceding enrollment—family to register at St. Laurence, a \$500 tuition credit will be given. It will be up to the two families to decide how, if at all that \$500 credit might be split.

In addition, families can also offset the tuition increase by participating in the Scrip program (formerly known as Manna) which is available to all St. Laurence families and friends. This is a program where gift cards can be purchased, and a portion of that sale price goes directly back to the school and a portion of the sale price goes directly to the designated school family as a tuition credit.

It is the policy of St. Laurence School to admit students of any gender, race, color, or national origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities made available to students.
